#### Course information

#### Content 1

The first block of the second year kicks off by delving into creative processes that are both familiar and unfamiliar to the animation student. The focus is on two-dimensional techniques. Each lesson revolves around a particular procedure and provides several starting assignments, although students are expressly encouraged to explore for themselves. The creative processes are experimental and challenge students to think more along the lines of material, technique and procedure, and to develop artwork and concepts on that basis.

Another goal of this setup is to create awareness of the students' habits and to fill any gaps in their artistic development.

Creative processes addressed: Experiment with machines, external factors, chance, wet-in-wet, destruction, combination.

The analogue works done in the lessons should be digitally processed every week.

The second part of this module has a reflective character, using all the expressive means in which design plays a role: the sketchbooks, the drawing work done in the lessons, artwork and of course the animations of the past year. Students are asked to form an idea of the characteristics and qualities of the work and the process that preceded it, and then to take steps for improvement and expansion. There is plenty of scope for alternative work plans, variations and experiments. What is style? What is the comfort zone? Where are the possibilities?

Learning objectives

Students:

- explore various experimental drawing techniques and related two-dimensional creative processes, and investigate the possibilities of these techniques;

- are able to apply these drawing methods within the context of their own designs;

- are able to give an impression of three-dimensionality in these pictures and use contrasts to create clarity in the image;

- are able to use various drawing methods in order to reinforce the artistic research;
- are able to reflect on their own work and that of others;
- are able to analyse and describe their own work process and draw conclusions from it the form of word and image;

- are able to enter into an artistic process, based on reflection on their own work, which demonstrates steps taken in relation to previous work.

- Is there a visible artistic process that links up with students' insights into their own work, and does this process demonstrate progress?

- Are students able to edit analog work with digital techniques and thereby able to integrate analog images into their digital workprocess?
