

Filmmaking 2A&B

During a period of 4 weeks you will work intensively in a small group of approximately 6 students on a personal film entitled "Self-portrait", in which you are supervised by 2 teachers. Each student realizes a short film of approximately 3 minutes during this module. After the 4 weeks in which you have made a self-portrait, a new module entitled "Family" starts. During this module, which lasts for 12 weeks, you will conduct extensive research into the theme and you make a film of approximately 10 minutes independently or in collaboration with other students.

Filmmaking 2 C&D

Filmmaking 2C consists of a film assignment with the theme "Society", in which you collaborate with fellow students and make a film of approximately 10 minutes within this theme. Filmmaking 2D is about "Reality" and with this film you position yourself as a maker and you present your craftsmanship and the way you work.

Film Skills

During each block, which lasts 8 weeks, you will be offered film skills. The film skills in year 2 build on what students have learned in year 1. In year 1 this was Storytelling, Concepting, Cinematography, Sound, Field research, Actors, and Film Production.

Film theory

The film theory classes that are offered in year 2 are linked to the filmmaking course. You will learn to do research on a specific theme and are offered a diverse range of theory classes. You will be assessed on how your research and the accompanying theory are reflected in the realized film in the Filmmaking module.

Cultural Studies

Cultural Studies is a theoretical course for exchange students on (Dutch) art and culture. As an exchange student at AVM you have the option to participate in this module, together with exchange students from other HKU courses.

Seminars

During week 9 and week 10 you participate in an intensive seminar program. There are no regular classes during those two seminar weeks. In the seminars you will:

- work together with students from other departments
- look beyond the walls of your own professional field, traditions and working processes
- gain new experiences and discover new interests
- experience different materials, experiments, disciplines, working methods, insights

Skillslab Media

Skillslab Media is a newly developed module in which media students can follow skills in other disciplines within HKU media (Photography, Animation, Graphic Design, Illustration Image & Media Technology).
