Content 1

You attend the tutorials (TH modules) within your own programme. During the tutorials, on the base of case-based assignments, you conduct in-depth research into the significance of current problems, discussions and ideas in the art world for your own discipline.

The Cultural Studies 2B module studies the following themes:

- new media
- cross-overs

With the aid of information from the lectures and the readers, you analyse the current context of your discipline: how does your discipline relate to the current debate on new media and cross-overs? You see what reflections you can find in your discipline of such current affairs based on one or more examples of current work. You prepare a presentation on the subject

In block 2, you also complete your research from the module Cultural Studies 2A, work on the presentation of your research and present the results to the group.

Explanation of tests

Participation requirements for interim examinations

1. Het ingeleverde vereiste werk niet genoeg aan de gestelde beoordelingscriteria voldoet en het totaaloordeel niet van het vereiste niveau is. In dat geval zal de student een verbetering (adhv mondeling/schriftelijk gegeven feedback) moeten doorvoeren en het vereiste werk weer opnieuw presenteren (uiterlijk in het eerstvolgende herkansingsmoment).
2. De student niet op komt dagen bij de beoordeling, niet genoeg aanwezig is geweest, of te vaak/te laat naar de les is gekomen.

HKU Media hanteert de regel dat een student alleen aan een 2e of 3e beoordeling kan deelnemen als er een gegronde reden is om de 1e beoordeling over te doen, namelijk in geval een beoordeling onvoldoende was of in geval een student vooraf heeft gemeld door ziekte of omstandigheden niet aanwezig te kunnen zijn. Mocht een student na drie keer geen voldoende beoordeling hebben, moet de module opnieuw worden gevolgd.
