Content 1

In this module, critical thinking is central and you learn to adopt a position and convey a founded standpoint. During classroom meetings and autonomous study, you explore historical and current discussions conducted in our profession. With this Design Discourse as a basis, you actively develop a critical reflective attitude.

Skills such as reading, listening, looking and writing critically constitute a major basis for reflective and editorial topics and support exercising a professional design practice. In this module, you actively develop these skills by reading and discussing texts, writing, giving feedback and excursions.

After completion, you will be able to consciously question the goal of your actions and your position and adopt a (related) standpoint

1. you work on developing skills such as critical reading, thinking and writing;
2. you learn to question the motivation of your own actions and adopt a founded standpoint in that respect;
3. you examine the current or historical discussions conducted in the profession (in both the professional and a broader cultural and societal context) and how you can relate to them.

Participation requirements for interim examinations

In dat geval zal de student een verbetering (adhv mondeling/schriftelijk gegeven feedback) moeten doorvoeren en het vereiste werk weer opnieuw presenteren (uiterlijk in het eerstvolgende herkansingsmoment).
2. De student niet op komt dagen bij de beoordeling, niet genoeg aanwezig is geweest, of te vaak/te laat naar de les is gekomen.

HKU Media hanteert de regel dat een student alleen aan een 2e of 3e beoordeling kan deelnemen als er een gegronde reden is om de 1e beoordeling over te doen, namelijk in geval een beoordeling onvoldoende was of in geval een student vooraf heeft gemeld door ziekte of omstandigheden niet aanwezig te kunnen zijn. Mocht een student na drie keer geen voldoende beoordeling hebben, moet de module opnieuw worden gevuld.
